

- NH still trends towards Biden, but around 50/50 Trump / Biden
- PA Biden has small chance here; 200,000 new Republican voters registered; likely to go for Trump
- WI pretty safe & early voting looking good
- MI getting closer in the polls; Benny thought this would be safe for Biden but polls are swinging towards Trump
- MN Trump has a good chance
- NV Benny thinks this will still stay blue due to Dems stealing it
- 4 Major indications:
 - Enthusiasm is on Trump's side (30-40% enthusiasm gap)
 - In every swing state, GOP voter registration is up 'through the roof':
 - 200,000 new registrants each in PA, AZ, FL
 - 150,000 in NC
 - Look where candidates are campaigning Biden would not be going to 'safe' states if they were really 'safe'
 - In Gallup poll, 56% of respondents said they were better off now than 4 years ago, despite COVID
- 60% of Dems usually vote early while only 30% of GOP usually votes early
- MI Trump needs to win independents here by 15% in order to win
- Oregon will likely stay blue, but Trump lost by 12% in 2016 and likely to only lose by 5-10%
- Bellwether states are Pennsylvania and Wisconsin
- Shy Trump voters are real



Benny's electoral college map improved by 10 EV!




How to read the polling numbers

- AZ: Kelly/McSally in a dead heat; President Trump has a solid lead by YouGov
- Arizona Senate race 2020: Senator Martha McSally vs. Democrat Mark Kelly:

DEM: 04/96 GOP: 90/07/03 IND: 40/47/04

Overall: 47.6/46.6/ 02.5 Mark Kelly



- Benny was 90% certain that GOP would hold the Senate.
- Since the call, he has changed his prediction to GOP 55 : DEM 43: IND 02

2018: GOP: 53 DEM: 45 IND: 02
2020: GOP: 55 DEM: 43 IND: 02

Takeover GOP: AL MI MN

DEM: COGOP holds AZ

- ME very close but Susan Collins should hold
- MI John James is surging at the right time and can pick off Gary Peters; he may drive more votes to Trump
- MN Benny thought it would stay blue during the talk, but he now thinks that Lewis can defeat the DEM incumbent
- NC Sen Tillis will overperform Trump and keep his seat
- IA Sen Ernst should win by 3-4%
- MT approval for Sen Daines improved after his debate against challenger
- Trump would need to win AZ by 7% for McSally to keep her seat, but it appears that she has been gaining ground since our talk



Key Senate Races

- Expected GOP pick up AL; DEM pick up AZ/CO
- 2020: GOP: 52 DEM: 46 IND: 02
- Updated Senate prediction: GOP: 55 DEM: 43 IND: 02
- Alabama Doug Jones (D) flip D ->R
- Arizona Martha McSally (R) tossup
- Colorado Cory Gardner (R) flip R -> D
- Maine Susan Collins (R) tossup
- Michigan Gary Peters (D) lean D but could flip D->R
- Montana Steve Daines (R) should stay R by small %
- North Carolina Thom Tillis (R) lean R



Key Gubernatorial Races

- Montana Steve Bullock (D) tossup or flip R
- North Carolina Roy Cooper (D) lean D but maybe tossup

- Montana will flip red
- North Carolina likely to remain in Dem control
